
ELEVATE DC:RFS x NYSA Sweden

International mentor network, creating a scalable, athletecentred system.






FOCUS EU+: RFS x transnational entry into DC

The **FOCUS Dual Career Project** is a bold step toward reimagining how Europe supports young athletes in navigating the complex journey between elite sport, education, and future careers.

Integrated Dual Career pathways


Connects elite football academies with universities, sports science, and career planning to create structured, evidence-based pathways that extend beyond sport

Equips young players with education, employability, digital skills, and strategic tools to navigate uncertain career transitions confidently




FOCUS EU+: Aims
