Recruitment for studies

University candidates – athletes

(members of the Polish National Team team, and/or is an individual athlete of Olympic disciplines who holds the rank of First Sport, Master of Sport or the title of International Master; and/or is a player of a sports team participating in the central championships organized by Polish Sports Associations) can be admitted without an exam or have additional points in the recruitment processs.

Personalised Plan and Study Program

AWF Katowice created The Individual Plan and Study Program (IPPS) system. It consists of an individual, tailored to a particular student, choice of subjects, as well as setting convenient dates for attending classes and exams.

The IPPS system helps to combine studies with a professional, scientific or sports career. It has a big impact on the decision to study by future students, mainly athletes.

Scholarships, funded by the government's budget and by the university's own resources

The best student-athletes can apply for scholarships from the university's Rector and the Minister of Science and Higher Education.

Using the modern research laboratories

The university hosts many research laboratories where student-athletes can engage in research projects with university scientists. The findings can enhance the effectiveness of their athletic training.

"National Academic Team" – The Polish Program Supporting Student-Athletes' Dual-Career

In 2020 the Ministry of Science and Higher Education in Poland started the program "National Academic Team" The program was directed to all Polish universities. The main objective of the program was to provide support for student athletes, enabling them to pursue university education in addition to their sports careers.

"National Academic Team" – The Polish Program Supporting Student-Athletes' Dual-Career

The program subsidises organizing additional classes for student athletes involved in their sport careers The study program is implemented throughout the entire academic year in the form of an individual course of studies, in accordance with scheduled additional hours assigned per each student Athlete. The funding amounts to PLN 20 000 (a bout EUR 4 7 00 per year per student and is dedicated to the arrangement of 100 hours of individual course of studies conducted by the academic teachers.
