University Network for Dual Mentoring of Student-Athletes (RUMDE)

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Background and Justification

The University Network for Dual Mentoring of Student-Athletes (RUMDE) is an initiative created to facilitate the integration of high-performance athletes into the university context, promoting an innovative mentoring model that enables the reconciliation of sporting and academic careers.

Despite legislative and theoretical advances regarding the dual career of student-athletes, no concrete and tailored actions have been implemented that allow significant progress in this area.

The RUMDE Network, created under the auspices of the 2024 Spanisch Sport Council Call, is advancing in its knowledge and action in supporting high-level student-athletes entering the University.







Spanish Legal Framework



Law 39/2022, of 30 December, on Sport

Article 24: **Rights** of high-level athletes **to receive guidance and support** for the development of the dual career.

Article 27: Rights of professional athletes to **reconcile** family, academic and professional life.

Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System (LOSU)

Article 22: **Universities** shall provide instruments to promote **effective compatibility** between **sporting practice** and students' **academic training**.

Article 33: Right to tutorials, **counselling** and psychopedagogical **guidance**.

This project is funded by the **Higher Sports Council (CSD)** and seeks to establish a specialized mentoring framework, promoting academic excellence and the overall well-being of these students.



Specific Objectives




Disseminate the MEDEAN model

Recruit new members


Incorporate into the Network new researchers, research groups and universities with expertise in these topics.

Project Implemetation





Procedure in Three Phases

Phase 1: Disseminate

Disseminate the MEDEAN model (Dual Mentoring for High-Level Student Athletes) among the scientific and academic community.

Phase 2: Publicise

Promote the RUMDE Network and its progress through social media and academic events.

Phase 3: Organise

Hold an International Congress to share experiences and advancements in dual mentoring: 11-12 December University of La Coruña (Spain)





Phase 1: DISSEMINATION Internal dissemination phase of the MEDEAN model

Present MEDEAN to the new researchers and groups joining the Network.

Assess the suitability for MEDEAN of the innovative proposals being carried out by the Network's new partners.





Phase 2: SPREAD THE WORD

External dissemination phase of the MEDEAN model

Promote and disseminate RUMDE at the '13th Annual AECD Congress', the 'EAS Congress' and the 'National University Sports Conference'.

Establish an exchange forum through the organisation of the "1st International Congress on Dual Mentoring"





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Phase 3: ORGANISE

Organise "1st International Congress on Dual Mentoring for High-Level Student Athletes"

Innovation of knowledge with ecological validity, creating a reference model for European universities.


Technological Impact


Development of a platform/application to manage mentoring of student-athletes.
