#### Erasmus+ Programme


- The EU's primary funding programme for education, training, youth, and sport, with a significant budget allocation for supporting sport-related projects.
- +/- €500 million for the period 2021-2027 - the largest EU funding source specifically targeted at promoting sport and physical activity.



## Cooperation partnerships

- Transnational projects with minimum 3 organisations from 3 different EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme
- Goal is to reinforce networks, boost the internationalisation of the organizations' activities, exchange best practices and share innovative ideas
- Budget available EUR 120 000, 250 000 or 400 000 (pre-fixed lump sums)





### Small-scale partnerships

- Transnational projects with minimum 2 organisations from 2 different EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme
- Goal is to attract less experienced organisations and small-scale actors to the programme, support social inclusion and active citizenship at local level
- Budget available EUR 30 000 or 60 000 (pre-fixed lump sums)





## Not-for-profit European sport events

- Organise 1 European-wide sport event in 1 country OR organise local sport events in each country involved (from EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme)
- Goal is to focus on volunteering and social inclusion, fight discrimination, encourage healthy lifestyle
- Budget available EUR 200 000, 300 000 or 450 000 (pre-fixed lump sums)





## Capacity building in the field of sport

- International cooperation between E+
   Programme countries and third countries not associated to the Programme in Region 1 (Western Balkans) and Region 2 (Neighbourhood East)
- Goal is to raise capacity of grassroots sport organisations, encourage physical activity and social inclusion, promote positive values and cooperation
- Budget available between EUR 100 000 and 200 000 (budget based lump sum)





#### European Week of Sport



- Part of the Erasmus+ Key Action 3
- Launched in 2015
- Every year on 23-30 September
- Goal is to promote physical activities at national level and via the #BeActive campaign
- Budget available EUR 320 000 per national coordinating body
- 50 000 events and 15 million participants in >30 participating countries for 2024





### **#BeActive EU Sport Awards**

- Since 2015 a central element of the European Week of Sport
- Goal is to reward outstanding initiatives that have successfully promoted sport and physical activity across Europe
- Previously two prizes, Be Active and Be Inclusive, since 2025 one single prize
- Five categories: Physical activity, Inclusion,
   Volunteering, Across generations, Peace
- Budget available EUR 125 000 in total, per winner EUR 15 000 per finalist EUR 5 000

Not-for-profit European Sport events

- European local event type I: 3-5 organisations, each from different country
- European event type II: minimum 6 organisations from 6 countries
- European-wide event: 1 applicant + 9 associated partners from 10 countries

Capacity Building

Minimum 4 organisations from 3 countries: 2 organisations from 2 different EU MS or third countries associated to the Programme + 2 organisations from at least 1 country of Region 1 or Region 2

#### - DUAL CAREERS PROJECTS

- 2021-2024: 153 projects funded (17 explicitly indicated Dual careers as main focus)
- Total budget awarded: EUR > 25 M
- Many of the projects currently still ongoing

- 2025: 81 projects selected (10 explicitly indicated Dual careers as main focus)
- Contractualization ongoing

#### SUMMARY / Objectives

SCALE uses football to combat dropout among students aged 14-19 by creating **flexible** school-football dual career paths, raising awareness among schools and teams, training coaches to promote education, and encouraging football teams to support players' academic success.

The project partners with national football federations from Malta, Romania, Italy, Moldova, and Azerbaijan, a training center, a vocational school association, and the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, with endorsement from UEFA and the UEFA Foundation for Children.

SCALE's key outcome is a set of guidelines for implementing dual career paths to balance football and education. Its sustainability is ensured through national football policies and UEFA-backed dissemination to 55 federations, expanding the model across the EU. SCALE highlights football's role in addressing social issues and promoting positive societal change.


#### SUMMARY / Objectives

ServeHER (SH) aims to promote education through sport and improve coaching quality in EU grassroots volleyball. It will develop and pilot an innovative dual career program to equip 50 female volleyball players (aged 16-17) with skills in coaching, club management, and statistics, supporting their career prospects beyond sports.

The project includes a research report on dropout reasons, a three-module program with virtual training and motivational videos, an ambassador network, a digital platform, and guidelines for European volleyball clubs. Partnering with the Bulgarian Volleyball Federation and Volley Belgium, ServeHER creates a unique dual career pathway to keep girls in volleyball and develop future female coaches, managers, and statisticians with relevant labor market skills.
